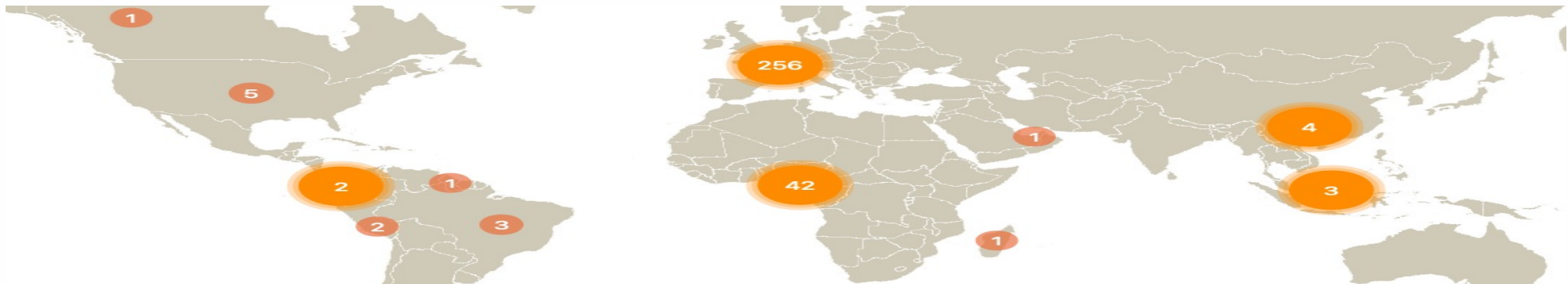


MY TROPICAL TIMBER, a tool for developing partnerships and to increase business in our sector.




